The purpose of this list is to help Atlanta Fly Fishing Club members to locate fishing partners for trips to local and long distance locations using their personal watercraft. When fishing rivers, it is always helpful (and adviseable) to have a partner and having 2 cars makes ferrying between "put-in" and "take-out" much easier especially locally where car ferry services do not exist like they do at major streams out west.

The list is sorted into 3 sections PONTOONS & KAYAKS (which can handle fast moving and shallow water), CANOES (for slower moving water – unless you're a good canoist and daring), and FLOAT TUBES (mainly for still or deeper water fishing – unless you like to freeze your legs on the Hooch). Since some folks have multiple watercraft, please look in all the sections for those that may also have your type of craft.
